- The challenge is to read up to 50 books in 50 weeks. One book per category; one category per book.
- Registration is limited to Marshall Public Library young adult patrons who have a library card.
- Finish and report completion by December 31, 2019. No late entries will be accepted.
- Record the books you finish. Write down the title and how it fits the category. Use the provided book log or create your own scrapbook or journal containing the same categories. This must be shown to a librarian at the conclusion of the challenge.
- Books you read for other programs and book clubs may also count for the Book Quest as long as it fits into one of the categories and you finish by December 31st.
- Audio books can be used for the Book Quest.
- Participants who finish and report by the December 31st deadline will be eligible for the Book Quest prize.
- There will be three prize levels: 13 books/26 books/50 books.
- Only one prize will be awarded, but the size of the prize will be based on the level completed which is determined by the total number of books finished.
- Prizes will not be ordered until the conclusion of the challenge and will be available for pick-up after March 1st, 2020. MPL will not ship prizes.
