## OVERDRIVE APP

Didn't have a chance to drop by the library? Want to take a book with you on vacation? Stuck without a book on a Sunday morning? We have the answer for you!

Marshall Public Library has just joined the Idaho Digital Consortium in offering a new service for borrowing e-books and audiobooks: OverDrive! OverDrive will be replacing our RBDigital service in providing electronic content to our patrons. Here are the steps for putting OverDrive on your smartphone or most tablets:



The Libby app is the easiest way to get started with digital books, audiobooks, and magazines from your public library!

- 1 Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android, iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), or Windows 10 device.
  - 2 In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
  - 3 Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
  - 4 Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi so you can read them when you're offline.
- From your **Shelf**, you can:
- Tap **Open Book**, **Open Audiobook**, or **Open Magazine** to start reading or listening.
  - Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew**, **Return**, or **Send to Device** to send a book to Kindle (U.S. libraries only).

## FOOD FOR FINES

Do you have overdue library books on your shelves? Now is the time to return that book, clear your fines, and help our neighbors in need!

We are happy to announce that we are partnering with the Idaho Foodbank for Food for Fines again this year! Food for Fines will be November 1st- December 15th. MPL will forgive \$1 in overdue fines for every non-perishable food item brought to the library. Non-perishable food items are shelf-stable foods such as canned fruits, vegetables, soups, boxed meals, pasta, and peanut butter. We cannot accept expired, home canned, repackaged, or perishable food.

Food for Fines does NOT include replacement fees for lost or damaged materials, collection agency fees, card replacement fees, or future overdue fines. If you have replacement fees for lost or damaged materials, all is not lost! We are happy to help, ask us about a payment plan.
