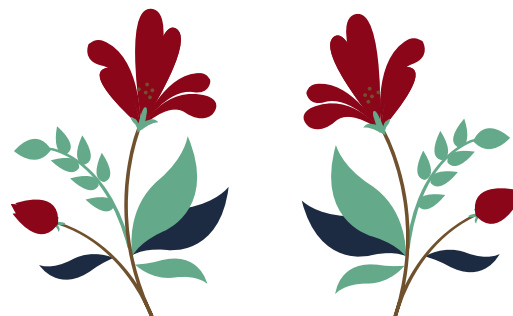
## SPRING BREAK ACTIVITIES
