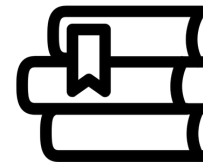
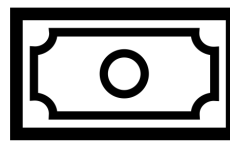
SPRING BOOK SALE
