

Heritage I & Heritage II: New Art by Kiana Spillman

MPL is proud to feature two new works by Southeast Idaho artist Kiana Spillman on our back stairs! Kiana's Swedish heritage informed the weavings; she designed their patterns after studying the history of Scandinavian woven pieces. Inspired by botany, people, and the creative process, she uses both traditional and innovative fibers, dyes, and techniques for her installations. *Heritage I & Heritage II* were woven with wool on a floor jack loom. Kiana used natural dyes including turmeric, avocado pit pigments, rose petals — and Kool-Aid! — to achieve their color.
